In the late 90s, C-Los relocated to Atlanta, working with Marvelous Development Center and Devyne Stephen's Upfront Megatainment. During his 30 years in entertainment, C-Los has been an Entertainment Consultant, Road Manager, Choreographer, Artist Developer, Show Developer, Actor, Singer, Dancer, Rapper, Director and working on projects with Sean "P-Diddy" Combs, Dallas Austin, Robert Townsend, Michael Jonsun, Johnny Wright, Maurice Starr, NKOTB, Lil John, TLC, Akon, Monica, OutKast, Jazze Pha, Goodie Mob, Raven-Symoné, Ludacris and Pink.
